## Uniform reminders for September

The academy has clear uniform expectations, which can be consulted on the OPA website. In light of the pandemic and the financial strain it placed on local families, we made the decision to show more leniency during the past academic year when addressing some of the uniform breaches, in particular those associated with shoe wear, school equipment and PE kit. However, from September, we expect all students to fully adhere to the uniform policy and wear the correct uniform every day.

Our uniform supplier is Snappy School wear https://www.snappyschoolwear.com/Store.php. Snappy Schoolwear will be having pop up shops at the Academy on 26th July 10am to 3pm, 16th August 10am to 3pm and there will also be a click and collect on August 31st from 9.30am to 11.30am.

Please make a note that the OPA standard uniform is as follows:

| Students are expected to have the following everyday: <br> Suitable school bag <br> Pencil case |  |

- Hairstyles - Only natural hair colour and tones are allowed. If you are thinking about changing the colour of your hair, speak to a member of the Pastoral Team first to check that it is within the Academy's expectations. Extreme styles and colours are not acceptable, including shaved or patterned styles.
- Jewellery - One watch and one pair of small, plain ear studs may be worn. NO other body piercing is permitted.
- False Nails - Gel or acrylic nails are not permitted. We accept clear nail varnish.
- Make-Up - Discreet/non-visible make-up is allowed, which means we should not easily see the student is wearing make-up. Any students wearing make-up that is obvious will have to remove it using face wipes. False eye-lashes are not permitted and these will need to be removed.
- Hair bands/Ribbons - must be plain black or plain white. Bandanas are not allowed


## Enforcement of the uniform policy

- Daily uniforms will be checked at the gates and line ups.
- No student will be permitted to engage in learning with the rest of the school community unless in full school uniform.
- Any non-uniform item of clothing (such as hoodies) or jewellery will be confiscated if seen on the academy site. Students will be able to collect the item at the end of the school day. Students who persistently breach the uniform code will be issued with an after school detention.

If your child has outgrown their uniform, please donate it to the school to support another family in the community.
